Miriam Frenkel is an Associate Professor in the Department of Jewish History and the School of History at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, where she completed her PhD. She has published extensively on the Geniza and on the cultural and social history of Medieval Judaism in the lands of Islam. Her books include *The Jewish Medieval Library*, edited with H Ben Shammai (2006) and *'The Compassionate and Benevolent': The Leading Elite in the Jewish Community of Alexandria in the Middle Ages*, (2006) which was awarded the Shazar prize.
